

HOW TO GET TO THE CIRCUIT

Q: Which is the best way to get to the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025?

A: The Circuit recommends the use of public transport to attend the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025 and that is why a wide and reinforced mobility offer in public transport will be available and will be launched a few weeks before the Grand Prix.

Q: What public transport options will be available?

A: As usual, there will be shuttle bus services from Barcelona and from the coast of Barcelona and there will be a reinforcement of the Rodalies de Catalunya train lines.

The following are the Rodalies de Catalunya train lines with stops near the Circuit.

- R2 (Barcelona Castelldefels - Granollers Centre). Stop at the Montmeló train station.
- R2 Nord (Aeroport - Maçanet-Massanes). Stop at the Montmeló train station.
- R8 (Martorell Central - Granollers Centre). Stop at the Montmeló train station.
- R11 (Barcelona Sants – Girona - Portbou). Stop at the Granollers Centre station.

Q: Will there be bicycle parking?

A: Work is underway to repeat the free bicycle parking from the 2024 edition, which was located near Gate 3.

Q: What will the car parking area look like?

A: We are working on the parking area for private cars that, as in the 2024 edition, will be located in the North and West areas of the Circuit. Spectators who want to come by private car will have to purchase a parking ticket beforehand (one ticket per vehicle).

It will not be possible to access this area without a parking ticket: vehicles without a ticket will be diverted outside the areas used as car park for the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025.

As in previous years, there will be several areas set aside for other groups (workers, Circuit Members, Hospitality, taxi area, bus parking, etc.). The general public will not be allowed to park in these areas.

The parking area for private cars will be closed at night, so it will not be possible to stay overnight. Caravans, motorhomes and similar vehicles are not allowed in this area.

Parking tickets are not yet on sale.

Q: Do motorbikes also have to pay for parking in the car parking area?

A: No. Motorcycles have free parking at the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025 in the general parking area. In this case, it is not necessary to obtain a ticket.

ACCESS TO THE CIRCUIT

Q: Which is the best time to access the Circuit?

FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025 will once again be a massive event with hundreds of thousands of spectators expected to attend. In order to avoid crowds, it is necessary to plan the journey to arrive as early as possible.

The access gates to the Circuit venue will be open from early in the morning during the three days of the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025. Moreover, access to the Circuit will be possible through any gate, regardless of the seat purchased.

Spectators should bear in mind that queues may form both at the entrance and exit due to the large number of spectators.

Q: What objects may not be taken?

A: Objects that may be considered dangerous or that are prohibited by current safety regulations for public events are not allowed. The following are not allowed:

- Any article that can be used or interpreted as a weapon and that may compromise the safety of other spectators and Grand Prix staff. In this regard, the entry of sharp objects, such as parasols and parasol poles, is expressly prohibited. Hand-held umbrellas (without tips) and the upper part of parasols are permitted.
- Banners, flags, symbols or other signs with messages that may be considered offensive, inciting to violence, terrorism or any kind of discrimination.
- Flares and smoke canisters.
- Glass, ceramic, wooden or metal containers. All cans are prohibited as, well as sun creams and thermos flasks in metal containers. Plastic or cardboard containers up to 1.5 litres are permitted.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal substances.
- Personal mobility devices such as scooters or bicycles. Access with prams and wheelchairs is permitted.
- Pets and other companion animals.
- Photography and video equipment for professional use and/or live broadcasting.
- Drones.

Q: Can I take photos or record videos during the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025?

A: Yes, photos and videos of the event may be taken as long as their use is strictly personal. Any use of the recorded material for commercial purposes will be prosecuted. Live broadcasts inside the Circuit are not allowed either.

Amateur audiovisual material is allowed as long as it is not considered a dangerous object, and its use is allowed as long as it does not disturb or obstruct the view of other spectators.

Q: Is the entry of flags and banners allowed?

A: National flags and banners that do not contain slogans, symbols or messages that may be considered offensive or incite violence are permitted.

These flags and banners may be hung on structural elements of the grandstands as long as they do not obstruct or block the view of other spectators. In such a case, these elements shall be removed.

Banners and flags must be removed at the end of each day. If they are not removed, the Circuit may dispose of them without any liability.

FUNCTIONAL DIVERSITY

Q: How will access to the Circuit be for users with functional diversity?

A: Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya will offer several services for people with functional diversity.

There will be two exclusive parking areas for vehicles with a parking card for people with functional mobility. The first area will be located in the West area of the Circuit, next to Gate 1; and the second one will be located in the East area of the Circuit, next to Gate 3. This area will be delimited and will offer this service until full capacity is reached.

People with functional diversity will have preferential access to the gates of the Circuit and, in addition, there will be an escort and mobility service for the public areas of the FORMULA 1 GRAN PREMIO DE ESPAÑA 2025.

OTHER QUESTIONS

Q: Will there be a camping area?

A: The camping area will be located in the West area of the Circuit and will be managed by the Montmeló City Council. All the details will be available soon on the website of the Montmeló City Council.

Q: Is free seating allowed on Friday?

A: No. Out of deference, it will not be possible to occupy the seat purchased by other spectators on any of the three days of the event. However, the general access area will be open to all spectators and it will be possible to walk all the way around the Circuit.

Q: Will there be the traditional Pit Walk?

A: We are working to repeat the traditional visit to the Pit Lane. When all the details (day, time and access conditions) are known, we will inform you through our website and social media.

Q: Will there be Pelouse Jove tickets?

A: Yes, Pelouse Jove tickets will be on sale in the coming months. These tickets are exclusively for young people aged 16-30 and will be valid for Sunday 1 June only.

Q: Will there be single day tickets?

A: The only single day tickets will be Pelouse Jove tickets. All other tickets will be 3-day tickets.
