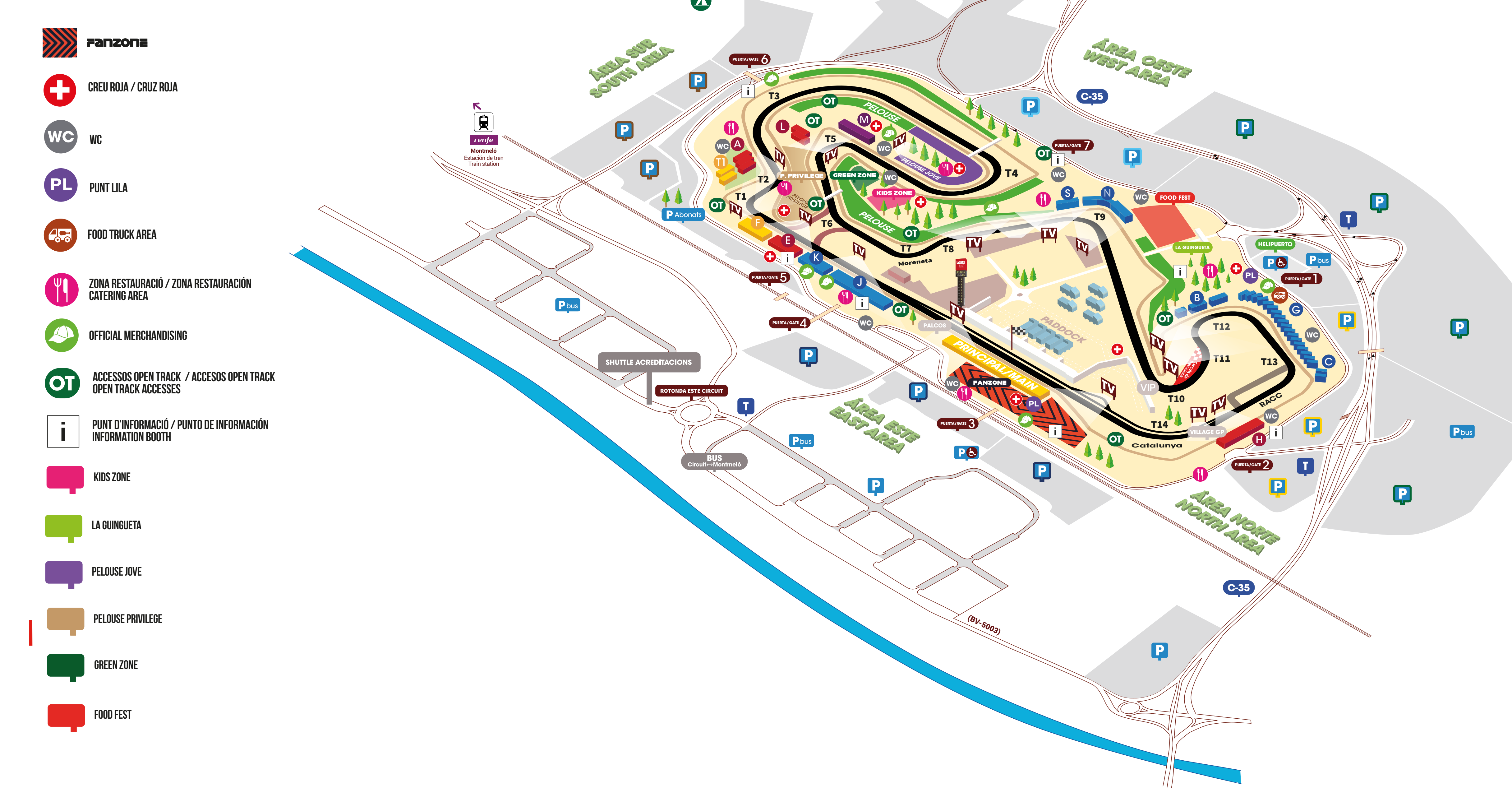

HOW TO GET TO THE CIRCUIT

A very high influx is expected this year during the weekend. We recommend you to come early! You can come own vehicle or public transport.

OWN VEHICLE:

Ask circuit.cat if there are places available. You need to purchase the ticket online and prior to your visit to the Circuit. Parking tickets will NOT be sold on the Circuit.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

- Sagalés bus from Barcelona and the Costa Brava/Costa de Barcelona.
- With Cercanías Renfe (line R2 north).
- By bus from Montmeló station to the Circuit (East Circuit roundabout). Connection with Bus Circular Circuit.

CIRCULAR BUS CIRCUIT:

From Friday to Sunday a circular bus will stop at all access doors. You can access the Circuit by any of doors. There will also be a stop at the Accreditation Center..
